



Prayer Points

1 - RECOGNITION / AWARENESS OF SIN

Scripture: Joel 2:12-13, NLT

“That is why the Lord says, ‘Turn to me now, while there is time. Give me your hearts. Come with fasting, weeping, and mourning. Don’t tear your clothing in your grief, but tear your hearts instead.’ Return to the Lord your God, for he is merciful and compassionate, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love. He is eager to relent and not punish.”

Sample Prayer:

Father, forgive us on the First Coast for all of the ways where we have tried to live our lives apart from you. We hear Your urgent call for us to turn to You with our whole hearts, and we respond today with fasting, prayer, and mourning for the ways we have strayed. Open the eyes of those who are trapped in sin and darkness, that they may recognize their distance from You. Open their hearts to see Your mercy, grace, forgiveness, and compassion. Thank You, Lord, for being slow to anger, and for Your unfailing love. Lord, let them return to You, trusting that You are eager to forgive and restore. Shine the light of Jesus into their lives, that they may know the freedom You offer them and the grace to walk in the warmth of Your presence.

2 - REPENTANCE - PERSONALLY AND ON BEHALF OF THE FIRST COAST

Scripture: II Chronicles 7:14, ESV

“If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

Sample Prayer:

Lord, we humble ourselves before You today. We ask for You to forgive us for our sins and the sins of those living on the First Coast. Forgive us for turning away from You and the truth of Your Word. We seek You today and ask for You to hear our prayers and heal our land.

3 - RECONCILIATION OF CHRISTIANS AND MESSIANIC JEWS

Scripture: Ephesians 3:6, NLT

“And this is God’s plan: Both Gentiles and Jews who believe the Good News share equally in the riches inherited by God’s children. Both are part of the same body, and both enjoy the promise of blessings because they belong to Christ Jesus.”

Sample Prayer:

Jesus, we thank You for reconciling Jews and Gentiles together through Your sacrifice on the Cross. You brought us into unity as one new family where the once was division. Help us to work together, pray together and serve one another as fellow brothers/sisters in Christ.

4 - REVIVAL ON THE FIRST COAST OF FLORIDA

Scripture: Psalm 85:6, ESV

“Will you not revive us again, that your people may rejoice in you?”

Scripture: Psalm 80:18-19, NIV

“Revive us, and we will call on your name. Restore us, Lord God Almighty; make your face shine on us, that we may be saved.”

Sample Prayer:

Lord, we have heard of the great revivals in the past and we know that You are not finished yet. Return to us, Oh God! Send an outpouring of Your Spirit to bring revival to the people of the First Coast. Send times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord to us we pray.

5 - RETURN OF JESUS CHRIST OUR MESSIAH

Scripture: Revelation 1:7-8, ESV

“Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen. ‘I am the Alpha and the Omega’ says the Lord God, who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.’

Sample Prayer:

Lord, we say, “Maranatha” – come Lord Jesus! We are looking forward to Your triumphant return. Help us to stay ready and to let others know that You are coming back again.
